After two terms on probation, a student who fails to make Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) by maintaining a 3.0 cumulative GPA, a 67% completion rate, and a 150% maximum degree completion timeframe will no longer be eligible to receive federal financial aid. Students may appeal to continue on a cash pay basis. Appeals are not guaranteed and are made at the discretion of the University. Students may apply for federal financial aid upon return to good academic standing.
